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8. Requirements to Pass Overall

8.1. Year 3 of the FdSc/BSc Veterinary Nursing

8.1.1. Modules

In order to pass a module a student must obtain an aggregated average of 50% from the assessment activities combined

AND

At least 40% in each individual assessment activity

AND

Gain a 'Pass' in any pass/fail component

8.1.2. FdSc/BSc Year 3 & Award of FdSc Veterinary Nursing

In order to pass Year 3 overall a student must achieve a pass in all modules

AND

To have completed the 1800 placement hours

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12.	<p>Disclosure of Marks</p> <p>Results will be published by candidate number.</p>
13.	<p>Absence from Summative Assessment</p> <p>Where a student has an <i>allowable</i> absence, they will be marked absent (A) from a summative assessment and will be required to sit the assessment activity at the next available opportunity.</p> <p>An allowable absence is one that is for a significant unforeseeable event such as illness. Any other foreseeable absence will only be considered allowable if agreed by the Student Performance and Development System (and this will only apply in very strictly limited circumstances.</p> <p>A student absent for any other reason will be awarded 0 (zero) for the assessment.</p>
14.	<p>Late Submission of Work</p> <p>Reports, Projects and Assignments submitted after the due deadline will be subject to the late submission policy set out in the College's General Assessment Regulations.</p> <p>Within this Year 3 the major pieces of work are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Business Plan and audit (assignment 1) - The Professional Veterinary Nurse (50% minimum) • Team based Knowledge Summary - Academic & Professional Development 3 (50% minimum)
