- x Contextual offers will only apply to GCE A Levels, these in combination the Advanced Welsh Baccalaureate Challenge Skills Certificate, and Scottish Highers/Advanced Highers for the time being (further details in Table 1.2). Those taking linear A Levels (e.g. in England or, in some cases Northern Ireland) who qualify for a contextual offer will still be expected to achievea 'Pass'in their sciencepractical for all natural science subjects.
